SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor (s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & MOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, if the full and just sum of Eifteen Thousand, Faye Hundred and No./100. (\$15,500.00.) Dollars (or for luture advances which may be made hereunder at the option of said Association, which advances shall not exceed the maximum amount stated became and shall be evidenced by a subsequent promissory note or notes se-

cured hereby), said note to be regain with interest at the rate specified therein in installments of

One-Hundred Seventeen and 53/100 - - - (\$ 117.53) Dollars upon the first day, of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest, has been plid, such monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid principal halances, and then to the payment of principal. The last gayment on said note, if not paid earlier and if not subsequently extended, will be due and payable 18. years after date.
