To A Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, J. C. Walker and Gladys Walker, of Greenville County

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor (s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Eight Thousand. One Hundred and No/100 = (\$8,100.00...)

Dollars (or for future advances which may be made hereunder at the option of said Association, which advances shall not exceed the maximum amount stated herein and stand be evidenced by a subsequent promissory snote or notes se-

cured hereby), said note to be repaid with interest at the rate specified therein in installments of

extended, will be due and payable 20 years after date. The note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or, interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Assectation, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder, become immediately due and payable, and the holder may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note lurther providing for ten (10%) per certum attorney's fee beside all costs, and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor (s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor (s). Inchand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents document, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lot Nor 182 of a subdivision, known as East Lynne Addition as shown on plat thereof prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May, 1933 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at page 220, and having, according to said plat, the following meters and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Ridgeway Drive, the joint front corner of Lots 181 and 182, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 69-42 W. 149 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said lots; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 182, N. 17-15 E. 50.05 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 182 and 183; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 69-42 E. 146. I feet to an iron pin on the western side of Ridgeway Drive, the joint front corner of said lots; thence with the western side of Ridgeway Drive, S. 14-32 W. 50.25 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to us by D. U. Mauldin by deed of even date to be recorded herewith.

In addition to the above mentioned monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, the mortgager (s) agree (s) to pay to the mortgagee on the first day of each month until the note secured by this instrument is fully paid, the following sums: a sum equal to the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes, and assessments next due on the mortgaged property (all as estimated by the mortgagee) less all sums already paid therefor, divided by the number of months to elapse before one month, prior to the date when such premiums, taxes, and assessments
