NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina: on the southeastern corner of the intersection of Rocky Knoll Drive and Augusta Road and being known and designated as Lot No. 77 of Pecan Terrace as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "GG", at Page 9 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Rocky Knoll Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 76 and 77 and running thence S. 64-34 W. 129.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 0-09 W. 106.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 16-01 E. 42.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 54-27 E. 90 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 38-42 E. 50.2 feet to the point of beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
