of record in the office of the R.M.C. of Greenville County, State of South Carolina, for value received does hereby release from the lien of said instrument(s) the following described property in said County and State:

All that certain piece, parcel or lots of landsituate, lying and being Cleveland township, Greenville County, South Carolina, known and designated as lots 7 and 8 of a subdivision known as Hart Valley Haven, owned by David W. and Imogene T. Osteen, according to a plat made by J. C. Hill, surveyor, March 10, 1955, recorded in the RMC office for Greenville county in plat book EE, page 137, reference to which is hereby made, the entire portion of both lots having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the S/S of a county road, joint corners of Lots 6 and 7, and running with the common line of said lots, S. 23-00 E., 176 feet to the center of Oil Camp Creek; thence following center of said creek as line in a northeasterly direction, 120 feet to the joint rear corners of Lots 8 and 9; thence with the common line of said lots 8 and 9, N. 23-00 W., 192 feet to the center of said county road; thence following said county road, S. 39-30 W., 68 feet; thence S. 78-15 W., 61 feet to the point of beginning, being subject to such rights-of-way or easements as may appear of record or previously given.

Only the above-described property is released from the lien of the aforesaid instrument(s). This release shall not affect or modify the obligations secured by the said lien instrument(s), and the said obligations shall continue in force and effect until fully paid, satisfied, and discharged.
