We, James R. Graham and N. Thomas Croker, hereby affirm and say that they are Vice-President and Trust Officer, and Assistant Trust Officer, respectively, of the South Carolina National Bank and as such are qualified to make the following statement.

The South Carolina National Bank was Executor of the estate of J. B. Hall, deceased, under the terms of his Will and was appointed as such by Order of the Probate Court of Greenville County on June 26, 1958, and served until dismissed by Order of the same Court on September 5, 1961.

As such Executor of the Estate of J. B. Hall, deceased, the South Carolina National Bank Trust Department received all the assets in the deceased J. B. Hall's estate, including all outstanding unpaid real estate mortgages.

It appears from the records of Greenville County that Kathleen M. Turner and Edward M. Turner gave a real estate mortgage to J. B. Hall in the original amount of Four Hundred and No/100 (\$400.00) Dollars, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County on March 26, 1954, in R. E. M. Volume 590, at Page 451, and that said mortgage is still open.

After a careful examination of the records of the assets of the estate of J. B. Hall, deceased, which were turned over to the South Carolina National Bank Trust Department as Executor of said estate, it appears that the mortgage mentioned above was not among said assets of the estate.
