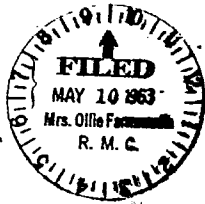

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE WITH  
INSURANCE CLAUSE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Ruth H. Cooley, of the County of Greenville, and - - - - - in the State aforesaid. SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I, the said Ruth H. Cooley, am indebted, - - - - - in and by my certain promissory note of even date herewith unto The Pelzer-Williamston Bank, in the principal amount of \$1,500.00, a copy of said note being as follows:

\$1,500.00 Williamston, S. C. May 9th, 1963.

ON DEMAND, FOR VALUE RECEIVED, I, Ruth H. Cooley, promise to pay to The Pelzer-Williamston Bank, Williamston, South Carolina, or order, the sum of Fifteen Hundred and No/100 (\$1,500.00) Dollars, with interest from date at the rate of Six (6%) per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually, and if not so paid when due to be added to the principal and the whole to bear interest at the rate of Six (6%) per cent. per annum.
