of Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

C. Douglas Wilson & Co.

a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Ten Thousand, One Hundred and Fifty and no/100 Dollars (\$ 10,150.00), with interest from date at the rate of five and one-fourth per centum ($5\frac{1}{4}$ %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of C. Douglas Wilson & Co. in Greenville, South Carolina or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Fifty-six and 13/100 Dollars (\$ 56.13), commencing on the first day of August, 1963, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of July, 1993

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina: in the City of Greenville, on the south side of Buist Avenue, being known and designated as parts of Lots Nos. 10 and 11, Block E, on plat of Buist Circle, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "C", page 10, and being more particularly described according to a recent survey of the property of Joe C. Garris, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, June, 1963, as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Buist Avenue, said iron pin being situate 254 feet from the southwest corner of the intersection of Buist Avenue and Townes Street, and running thence S. 9-45 W. 148 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Ashley Avenue; thence with the north side of Ashley Avenue N. 89-28 W. 16.95 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 9-45 E. 41.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 80-15 W. 30 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 9-45 E. 43.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 80-15 W. 10 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 9-45 E. 63.8 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Buist Avenue; thence with the south side of Buist Avenue, S. 80-15 E. 56 feet, to the point of beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

To HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
