Greenville, S. C. hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto AIKEN LOAN & SECURITY COMPANY

organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, a corporation hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED Dollars (\$6,500.00), with interest from date at the rate of five & one-fourth per centum (5 1/4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of Aiken Loan & Security Company in Florence, South Carolina or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Thirty-nine and no/100 Dollars (\$39.00), commencing on the first day of October, 1953, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of September, 1958.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina:

All that lot of land in the county of Greenville, state of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 42 on plat of North Sunset Hills subdivision recorded in plat book L page 92 of the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., said lot having a frontage of 60 feet on the northwest side of Beth Drive (formerly Elizabeth Drive), a depth of 164 feet on the southwest side, a depth of 175 feet on the northeast side and a rear width of feet.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

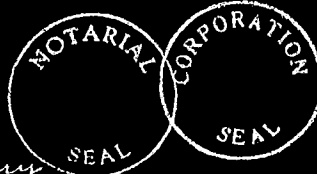
