GOSSETT, being hereinafter known and designated as the MORTGAGOR, and THE EQUITABLE LIFE ASSURANCE SOCIETY OF THE UNITED STATES, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, having its principal office in the Borough of Manhattan, of the City of New York, being hereinafter known and designated as the MORTGAGEE;

WITNESSETH, WHEREAS, the said mortgagor is justly indebted to the said mortgagee in the sum of Twenty-three Thousand Five Hundred and No/100<sup>ths</sup> Dollars (\$23,500.00) and has agreed to pay the same with interest thereon, according to the terms of a certain note or obligation bearing even date herewith, to which note reference is specifically made, providing for the payment thereof in instalments, the last of which is due and payable on the first day of October 1963.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH, that the mortgagor, for the better securing the payment to the said mortgagee of the said sum of money mentioned in said note or obligation, with interest thereon, and also for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to the mortgagor in hand paid by the mortgagee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said mortgagee, its successors and assigns, forever all that piece or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville County of Greenville, South Carolina, described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being at the South-western corner of the intersection of Yorkshire Drive, formerly Mable Avenue, and Lee Drive near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 67 as shown on Plat No. 2 of James M. Edwards, prepared by Dalton & Neves, dated August, 1955, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book II at page 120, and having according to said plat and also according to a more recent plat prepared by T.C. Adams, dated March 7, 1957, entitled "Property of Albert Clinton Gossett, Jr. and Anna B. Gossett", the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Yorkshire Drive, formerly Mable Avenue, at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 67 and 68, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 68 N. 54-26 W. 214.2 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 4; thence with the line of Lot No. 4 N. 42-52 E. 100 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Lee Drive; thence with the Southern side of Lee Drive S. 54-55 E. 178 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Lee Drive and Yorkshire Drive, formerly Mable Avenue, the chord of which is S. 9-13 E. 35 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Yorkshire Drive, formerly Mable Avenue; thence with the Western side of Yorkshire Drive, formerly Mable Avenue S. 36-29 W. 75.2 feet to the point of beginning.
