TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

Merrill C. Wilson and Nina S. Wilson

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Twenty Seven Thousand Seven Hundred and no/100-----

DOLLARS (\$27,700.00-----), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Five & three-fourths per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid in monthly instalments of One Hundred Ninety-Four & no/100 Dollars (\$194.00) each on the first day of each month hereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid; each payment to be applied first to payment of interest and then to payment of principal, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

^{those two} All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Southeastern side of Dreamland Way, Paris Mountain Township, being shown as Lot No. 3 and an unnumbered lot on a plat of the property of Ruth H. Jamison, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book T at page 326, and when described together have the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Dreamland Way, at the corner of Lot 4, and running thence with line of said lot, S. 31-40 E. 321.3 feet to iron pin; thence N. 66-39 E. 264.7 feet to iron pin; thence N. 42-05 W. 341.8 feet to iron pin on the Southeastern side of Dreamland Way; thence with the Southeastern side of Dreamland Way, S. 66-19 W. 100 feet to iron pin; thence continuing with the Southeastern side of Dreamland Way, S. 65-56 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

These lots are shown on the Greenville County Block Book as Map 443, Block 1, Lots 3.1 and 3.2, and being the same lots conveyed to the mortgagors by deeds recorded in Deed Book 706 at page 97 and Deed Book 694 at page 276.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture be considered a part of the real estate.
