Dollars, in and by its certain promissory note in writing, of even date herewith, due and payable on or before six (6) months from the date hereof, and upon demand thereafter,

with interest from the date hereof, at the rate of Five and One-Half (5½%)
percentum until paid; interest to be computed and paid Semi-Annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including ten per cent of the indebtedness as attorney's fee, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land with any improvements thereon situate, lying, and being on the western side of West Castle Road in Pine Hill Village, Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, shown and designated as Lot 164, on a plat of Pine Hill Village, prepared by R. K. Campbell, R.L.S., dated July 9, 1962, and recorded in the Office of the R.M.C. for said County and State in Plat Book "QQ", Page 168, and according to said plat being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of said Road, joint corner of Lots 142 and 164, and running thence S. 73-58 W. 60 feet along the joint line of said lots to an iron pin, joint corner of said Lots and Lot 163; thence N. 51-42 W. 119.5 feet along the joint line of Lots 163 and 164 to an iron pin on the southern side of West Castle Road, joint corner of said lots; thence along the southern and western sides of said Road, on a series of curves, the chords and lengths of which are as follows - N. 44-20 E. 36 feet, N. 51-03 E. 35.2 feet, N. 71-52 E. 17 feet, S. 85-39 E. 36.7 feet, and S. 38-32 E. 37.1 feet to an iron pin on the western side of said Road; and, thence S. 16-02 E. 82 feet along the western side of said Road to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
