Childs by deed dated February 28, 1934, whereof the central portion was heretofore conveyed to Charles Reyner and Lillian R. Reyner by R. S. Holding Company, Inc. by deed dated November 10, 1931, and whereof the southern portion was heretofore conveyed to Hortense S. Reyner by Jennie Huseman Metz by deed dated July 1, 1928, said deeds being recorded in office of Clerk of Court for Richland County, respectively, in Books of Deeds DW at Page 32, DH at Page 127, and DC at Page 376.

The lot hereby conveyed is also shown and delineated upon a plat embracing the same prepared by Tomlinson Engineering Company dated 2 February, 1934, as commencing on the eastern side of said Main Street in the center of a party wall at a point fifty-six feet seven and one-half inches N 19-00 W from the intersection of the eastern side of Main Street with the northern side of Hampton Street and running thence along the eastern side of said Main Street N 19-00 W sixty-six feet, one and one-half inches; thence turning at right angle and running along an alley as shown on said plat N 71-00 E one hundred fifty-five feet four inches to an iron stake; thence turning at a right angle and running along lot of J. W. McCormick S 19-00 E sixty-six feet three and $\frac{3}{4}$ inches to an iron stake; thence turning at a right angle and running along lot of Visanska S 71-00 W one hundred and fifty-five feet four inches to the point of commencement.
