TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

**PATRICIA M. BARNES** (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of **Eleven Thousand Five Hundred and No/100ths**-----

**DOLLARS (\$ 11,500.00** ), with interest thereon from date at the rate of **five & three-fourths**-- per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid in monthly instalments of **Ninety-five and No/100ths**----- Dollars (\$ **95.00** ) each on the first day of each month hereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid; each payment to be applied first to payment of interest and then to payment of principal, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Southeastern side of Washington Place also known as East McBee Avenue in the City of Greenville, and having according to a survey prepared by R.E. Dalton, the following metes and bounds:

**BEGINNING** at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Washington Place at the corner of property now or formerly of Goodyear, and running thence with the line of said Goodyear property S. 15-57 E. 331.3 feet to a fence post on the edge of the right-of-way of the C. & W.C. Railroad; thence with the Northern edge of said right-of-way S. 69-03 W. 50 feet to a fence post at the rear corner of property now or formerly of Morrison; thence with the line of said Morrison property N. 15-25 W. 320.2 feet to an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Washington Place; thence along the Southeastern side of Washington Place N. 56-00 E. 50 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the identical property conveyed to the mortgagor herein by deed of J.J. McDevitt and Roma M. Scott, Executrix of the Estate of Mae C. McDevitt, deceased, dated April 7, 1964, and to be recorded herewith in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.
