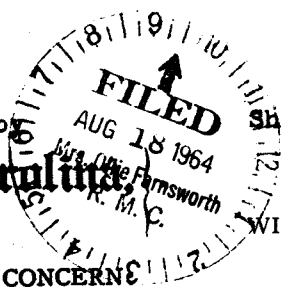

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Shell Homes Inc. of Anderson
hereinafter called the Mortgagor, are well and truly indebted to WINCHESTER GRAHAM, INC.,
hereinafter called the Mortgagee, in the full and just sum of Seven Thousand Eight
Hundred Ninety Six And No/100 Dollars, evidenced by a certain promissory note in writing of even date
herewith, which note is made a part hereof and herein incorporated by reference, payable in 168 monthly
installments of Forty Seven And No/100 Dollars
each, the first installment being due and payable on or before the 1st day of September, 1964,
with interest at the rate of six per cent. (6%) per annum from the date of maturity of said note until paid, and said Mort-

and for better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms and tenor of said note, and also in consideration of
THREE (\$3.00) DOLLARS to them in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee, all that tract or lot of land lying, being and situated in Greenville
County, State of South Carolina and described as follows, to wit:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon; situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina. Being the Eastern half of Lot No. 22 on a Sub-division plat recorded RMC0- BK "S", Page 53, more particularly described: Beginning at an iron peg on the West side of Chestnut Street, approximately Two Hundred Sixty-Seven (267) feet North of Bruce Street, and running in a Northerly direction for Fifty (50) feet, fronting on Chestnut Street, to an iron peg; then in a Westerly direction for One Hundred (100) feet to an iron peg; then in a Southerly direction for Fifty (50) feet to an iron peg; then in a Easterly direction for One Hundred (100) feet back to BEGINNING point. Said lot being rectangular in shape; bounded on the West by the Western half of Lot No. 22; bounded on the South by Lot No. 20; bounded on the East by Chestnut Street.
