TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: Bertha B. Pittman Atkins

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of - - - - - ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100THS - - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 1,350.00 ), with interest thereon at the rate of six & one-half per cent per annum as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date herewith payable as therein stated, or as hereafter modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is two years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, shown and designated as Lot 28, Section 2 on plat of Monaghan Mill Village recorded in Plat Book S at page 180 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southernside of Moody Street at the joint front corner of Lots 27 and 28 and running thence with the southern side of Moody Street, N. 6-23 E. 80 feet to pin; thence S. 86-23 E. 109 feet to pin on 15-foot alley; thence with said alley, S. 7-24 W. 80 feet to pin at rear corner of Lot 27; thence with the line of Lot 27, N. 86-23 W. 107.6 feet to the point of beginning.

This being the same property conveyed to the Mortgagor under the name of Bertha B. Pittman recorded in Deed Book 382 at page 192.
