WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto CAMERON-BROWN COMPANY

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that lot of land with improvements situate on the northern side of West Boulevard in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 18 on a Map of WEST BOULEVARD, Property of I. Saul, made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, dated August, 1924, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book F, Page 246, reference to which is hereby craved. This property faces on the northern side of West Boulevard for a distance of 60 feet and runs back in parallel lines a distance of 156 feet, more or less.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
