ALL that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land, lying, situate and being in Grove Township, approximately 250 yards West of Greenville-Greenwood Highway known as U. S. #25 approximately 9 miles South of Greenville County Courthouse and shown as Lot No. 1 on plat made by Terry T. Dill, Reg. GE & LS No. 104, dated May 19, 1964, said plat being recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book HHH, at Page 115, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
