To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, George M. Burns and Nancy K. Burns, of Greenville County,

...(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

Eleven Thousand and No/100-----(\$ 11,000.00)

Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, said note to be repaid with interest at the rate

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the opings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, on the western side of West Sable Court being shown as Lot 28 on a plat of Blue Mountain Park recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE at Page 121 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of West Sable Court, joint front corner of Lots 28 and 27 and running thence with said Court, S. 26-50 E. 110.0 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots 28 and 29; thence with the side lot line of said lots, S. 63-10 W. 142.8 feet to an iron pin on branch, joint rear corner of said lots; thence with the meanderings of branch in a northwesterly direction 110 feet, more or less, to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 28 and 27; thence with the side lot line of said lots, N. 63-10 E. 137.3 feet to an iron pin on West Sable Court, point of beginning; being the same conveyed to us by J.
