WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FOUNTAIN INN FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF Fountain Inn, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Eleven Thousand and No/100

DOLLARS (\$ 11,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six & one-fourth per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and (6 1/2)

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Austin Township, being known as Lot No. 26 on a Plat of Beechwood Hills, recorded in Plat Book QQ, at page 35, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING AT A Point on the Eastern side of Beechwood Drive at the joint corner with Lot No. 1, and running thence along the said Beechwood Drive, N. 20-03 W. 194.7 feet to the joint corner with Lot No. 27; thence along said Lot No. 27, N. 80-45 E. 174.4 feet; thence S. 3-38 E. 192.2 feet to a point on the line of Lot No. 1; thence with the line of Lot No. 1, S. 80-45 W. to the point of beginning
