and assigns, FOREVER:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the South side of Morgan Street, in City View, known and designated as Lot No. 43 on a plat of Morgan Hills Additions, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said County and State in Plat Book "A" on Page 60, and, according to said plat, described as follows:
BEGINNING at a point on Morgan Street at the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 42 and 43, and running thence with the joint line of said Lots S. 74½
