All that certain parcel or lot of land situated at the intersection of Buddy Street and State Highway No. 14, near Pleasant Grove Baptist Church about one mile southward from the City of Greer, State of South Carolina, and being Lot No. 5 of WOODLAND HEIGHTS, property of I.M. Wood Estate, according to survey and plat by T.G. Adams, Engineer, recorded in Plat Book GG, page 151, R.M. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:
