

It is expressly understood and agreed that no other terms of the aforesaid note and mortgage are in any way changed, altered or amended by this agreement other than the prepayment privilege, which shall be as follows:

"The following prepayment privileges are reserved: (1) On any interest payment date to make additional principal payments; provided, however, that the total of such payments made during any twelve month period calculated from the date of the note, or any anniversary thereof, shall not exceed \$5,000.00; (2) on any interest payment date during the first ten years of this loan, to make additional principal payments in excess of the amount provided under (1) above up to, and including, the entire balance due on the loan with a charge of 3% of such excess as consideration; (3) and thereafter on any interest payment date to make such additional principal payments without penalty."
