released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Pickensville Company, its
heirs and assigns; FOREVER:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the
Easterly side of Woodside Avenue near the City of Greenville, State of South
Carolina and being shown as Lot No. 15 on the plat of Morgan Hill addition as
recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A at pages
68 and 70, and also being more particularly shown ~~as~~ on a plat of the property
of Dora L. Snipes Estate, et al., as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for
Greenville County in Plat Book V, at apge 112 and having, according to last
