All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the East side of U. S. Highway #29, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 127 on Plat of Chestnut Hills, dated March, 1954, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "GG" at page 35, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of U. S. Highway #29 at the joint front corners of Lots 128 and 127 and running thence along the joint lot lines S. 88-40 E. 130 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear lot line N. 1-20 E. 37.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 70-34 W. 135.7 feet to an iron pin on the East side of U. S. Highway #29; thence along the East side of U. S. Highway #29 S. 1-20 W. 80 feet to an iron pin at the beginning corner.
