TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

John H. McFerrin and Margaret J. McFerrin  
(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of **Twenty-three Thousand and no/100-----** DOLLARS (\$ 23,000.00 ), with interest thereon at the rate of **five & one-half** per cent per annum as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date herewith payable as therein stated, or as hereafter modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is **fifteen** years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being shown and designated as Lot 190 and a part of Lot 189 on plat of Cleveland Forest, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M at Page 157 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southern side of Dogwood Lane at the joint front corner of Lots 190 and 191 and running thence with joint line of said lots S. 25-03 E. 181.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 72-15 W. 90 feet to a point in the center of the rear line of Lot 189; thence through the center of Lot 189 N. 25-28 W. 172.6 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Dogwood Lane; thence with the south side of Dogwood Lane N. 70-54 E. 30 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said lane N. 64-38 E. 60 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
