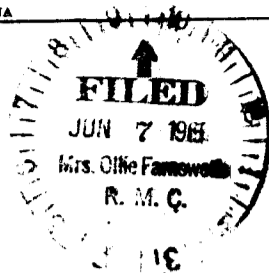

to be paid at the rate of Twenty and no/100 dollars (\$20.00) each month until interest and principal is paid in full.

with interest thereon from May 21, 1966 at the rate of 7% per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection the Mortgagor(s) agrees to pay all costs and expenses including a reasonable amount as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

E.H. Edwards, his heirs and assigns forever;

ALL that certain lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situated, lying and being in Greer Mill Village, in the City of Greer said state and county, and being more particularly described as lot No. 106 as shown plat entitled Subdivision of Greer Mill Village, Greer, S.C. made by Dalton & Neeves January 1951, and recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in plat Book Y at page 138 and 139, according to said plat, the within described lot of land is also known as No. 9 Gallivan Street and fronts thereon 76 feet.
