organized and existing under the laws of North Carolina, hereinafter called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of **Fourteen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty and no/100** Dollars (\$14,950.00), with interest from date at the rate of **Five & One-fourth** per centum (5 1/4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of **Cameron-Brown Company** in **Raleigh, North Carolina**, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of **Eighty-two and 67/100** Dollars (\$82.67), commencing on the first day of **August**, 1965, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of **July**, 1995.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of **Greenville** State of South Carolina;

ALL that lot of land situate in Greenville County, South Carolina, known and designated as Lot 176 as shown on a plat entitled South Forest Estates recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, page 181.

Lot size is 80 x 135.7 x 80.4 x 144.2.

Should the Veterans Administration fail or refuse to issue its guaranty of the loan secured by this instrument under the provisions of the Servicemen's Readjustment Act of 1944, as amended, within sixty days from the date the loan would normally become eligible for such guaranty, the mortgagee may, at its option, declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable.
