Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina on the east side of Old Paris  
Mountain Road, lying south of and adjoining the right of way of the old main line of  
Southern Railway, being Lots 57, 58, 59, 60 and part of 61 as shown on plat of  
property of McGee Trust Estate, recorded in Plat Book M at Page 51, R. M. C. Office  
for Greenville County, and being more particularly described in one boundary as follows:

Beginning at a pin on the east side of the Old Paris Mountain Road in the southern line  
of the right of way of old main line of Southern Railway, corner of Lot 60 and running  
thence with line of said right of way S. 82-24 E. 221.7 feet to a point on line of Lot
