WHEREAS We, Floyd Wood and Annie Bell Wood, are well and truly indebted to Agnes S. Dawsey in the full and just sum of Three Thousand, Three Hundred and No/100----- (\$ 3, 300. 00) Dollars, in and by our certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith, due and payable as follows: in monthly installments of Fifty and No/100 (\$50. 00) Dollars each, beginning on the 1st day of October, 1965 and continuing on the 1st day of each succeeding calendar month thereafter until the principal debt has been paid in full, said payments to be applied first to interest and then to the principal balance remaining due from month to month, with privilege of anticipating the principal debt, or any part thereof, at any time prior to maturity,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Agnes S. Dawsey, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Dunean Mills Village, being more particularly described as Lot No. 26, Section 1, as shown on plat entitled "Subdivision of Dunean Mills, Greenville, S. C.", made by Pickell and Pickell, Engineers, June 7, 1948 and August 7, 1948, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "S" at pages 173-179, inclusive. According to said plat the within described lot is also known as No. 4 Webb Street and fronts thereon 55 feet; being the same conveyed to us by Agnes S. Dawsey by deed of even date to be recorded herewith.

And we do hereby bind ourselves, our Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said mortgagee, her Heirs and Assigns, from and against us, our Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
