WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FOUNTAIN INN FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF Fountain Inn, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Oaklawn Township containing 1.79 acres according to a plat and survey of the property of Charles William Coker by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, dated December 11, 1945 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Sandy Springs Church Road at a point approximately 489 feet from the center line on the Augusta Road and running thence N. 11-00 W. 300 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 74-30 E. 246.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 11-00 E. 300 feet to an iron pin on the Sandy Springs Church Road; thence along said road, S. 75-00 W. 246.9 feet to the point of beginning.
