To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, Evan D. Ginn and Christine H. Ginn, of Greenville County,

_ (hereinafter reterred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

therein specified in installments of . One Hundred Twenty-Two and 87/100----(\$ 122.87 ...) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter in advance, until the principal sun, with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment if not sooner paid, to be due and payable .20 ... years after date; and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgage, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to insutute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW. KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgage at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 101, Section II, Lake Forest, as per plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book EE, page 71, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwesterly side of Berryhill Road, joint front corner Lots 100 and 101, and running thence S. 43-05 W. 289.7 feet to a point in Brushy Creek, joint rear corner Lots 100 and 101; thence with Brushy Creek as the line, the traverse line being N. 35-34 W. 149.4 feet to a point, joint rear corner Lots 101 and 102; thence N. 51-44 E. 230 feet to an iron pin on the Southwesterly side of Berryhill Road, joint front corner of Lots 101 and 102; thence along Berryhill Road, S. 39-48 E. 115 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to us by H.
