"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all Improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville on the southwest side of Beattie Place and being more fully described according to a plat of property of Sallie H. Foster, dated April, 1959, by C. O. Riddle, said plat being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book TT at Page 139.

BEGINNING at a pin on the southwest side of Beattie Place and running thence S. 34-31 M. 124.9 feet to a point on Oak Street Extension; thence running S. 55-58 E. 38.7 feet to a point, joint corner of land of Paul J.
