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# Church Resolution Authorizing Issue of Bonds

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## DIRECTORS CHURCH BONDS ATLANTA, GEORGIA

It is the desire of the Hillcrest Baptist Church

corporation, to provide adequate improvements on the property it now holds and to equip said improvements so that the property may better serve the purposes for which it is intended. The matter of the desired improvements to the property of the aforesaid Church is known and described as follows:  
All those pieces, parcels, or tracts of land, located on East side of White Horse Road, Berea section, Greenville County, South Carolina; Containing six & eight tenths (6.8) acres +, being the same property conveyed to Washington Ave. Baptist Church and subsequently to Hillcrest Baptist Church, by Harold Vaughn. And by W. M. Burdine to Hillcrest Baptist Church. Property bounds are as follows, Beginning at a stake on East side of White Horse Rd. and running N62-42E for a distance of approx. 645' then N17-43W for a distance 420' then N62-23E for a distance of 699' then S11-57E, 100'-S8-52E, 100'-S5-54E, 145' to point of beginning. This property is bound on the North by lands of Janie H. Wells, on the East by property of the Berea High School, on the South by property of W. M. Burdine and others and on the West by White Horse Road. For references see platt by C. C. Jones, CE dated June 1964, Revised March 1965, and Plot Plan by W. E. Freeman, Jr. and Associates dated September 20, 1965.

Said Church met in special conference on the 18th day of November 1965 and upon consideration of the membership, and after a general discussion of the matter, it was on motion duly made and carried;

RESOLVED, that the aforesaid Church of said City and State herinafter described as the Church and/or Corporation, does go on record as approving the proposed improvements of the Church property by erecting a new Educational Building and temporary Chapel, furnishing and equipping same and landscaping grounds.

Said improvements to cost approximately \$ 120,000.00

RESOLVED FURTHER, that said Church hereby adopts the plan as suggested by DIRECTORS CHURCH BONDS, of Atlanta, Georgia, in the issuance of a series of coupon bearing bonds aggregating \$ 150,000.00 One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars, which same shall be the unconditional obligation of the Church Corporation without the individual liability of any member or officer of said Corporation, and by this Resolution authorizes the issuance of said bonds and coupons having principal amounts, maturity dates, and serial numbers according to maturity schedule attached hereto.
