




RENUNCIATION OF DOWER

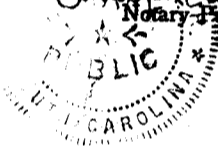
I, Edward P. Riley, Jr., Notary Public for South Carolina, do hereby certify unto all
