

WHEREAS, I, Lila W. Gentry

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State or South Carolina, County of Greenville, Fairview Township, containing $55\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less, with the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone on Reedy River and running thence N. 67 E. 12-69 chains to stone 3 x on poplar; thence S. 60 E.12.85 chains to stone 3 x on willow tree in branch; thence S. 27 3/4 W. 18.48 chains to stone 3 x; thence S. $62\frac{1}{4}$ E. 10.00 chains to stone 3 x; thence S. 463/4 W. 13.40 chains to stone 3 x in branch; thence S. along branch to the center of Reedy River; thence with said river to the beginning corner, and bounded by lands now or formerly of D.L. Thomason, C. T. Thompson and others. Being the same tract of land conveyed to Lila W. Gentry by deed of Van W. Thompson redorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 521, at page 151.

Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had thereform, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any-part thereof.
