

at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said THOMAS & HOWARD COMPANY OF COLUMBIA, S. C., its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being partially in the County of Greenville and partially in the County of Laurens, State of South Carolina, containing 44.27 acres, more or less, and shown on a plat of property of F. A. Thomason recorded in the office of Clerk of Court for Laurens County in Plat Book 16 at Page 56 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin near the southwestern side of S.C. Highway 418 on the line of property now or formerly of Mary Templeton, and running thence N. 52-20 E crossing said highway, 393 feet to an iron pin located S. 19-0 E. 67.0 feet from b.c. at the center of Highway 418: thence N. 19-0 W. 574 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 8-25 E 1294 feet to a stone; thence N. 72-51W 1056.4 feet to corner; thence N. 41-0 W. 165 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 40-54 W. 321.7 feet to a stone or the line of property of Mary Templeton; thence with the Templeton line S. 46-15 E. 541.0 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 48-45 W 634 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 38-30 E. 183 feet to maple and iron pin; thence S. 36-45 E. 1648.0 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning. Less however, a tract shown on said plat as Lot "B" containing 1 acre and lying on the western side of dirt road running through the said tract, which 1 acre was conveyed by a predecessor in title to John Henry and Sarah J.
