TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: **J. W. James and Pearlie James**

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(\$) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of

----- **Forty-Five Hundred and No/100** ----- DOLLARS
(\$ 4500.00), with interest thereon at the rate of **6½** per cent per annum as

evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date herewith payable as therein stated, or as hereafter modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is **12 +** years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced or readvanced to or for the Mortgagor's account, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, 'its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, **in the City of Greenville, shown as Lot 14 and part of Lot 27 and part of an abandoned street, all of which is shown on plat of Property of H. H. Harris, recorded in Plat Book A at page 225, and having according to a more recent survey made by Carolina Engineering Company, October 1, 1964, the following metes and bounds:**

Beginning at an iron pin on the southern side of Wakefield Street, formerly Grove Street, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 13 and 14, and running thence with Wakefield Street, S. 86-E. 70 feet to a pin; thence S. 1-07 W. 150 feet to pin; thence N.86 W. 70 feet to pin; thence N. 1-07 E. 150 feet to pin on Wakefield Street, the point of beginning.
