ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the north side of Fairlawn Circle, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S.C., being shown as Lot No. 20, on plat of Section II of Fenwick Heights, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book QQ, page 49, said lot fronting 110 feet along the north side of Fairlawn Circle and running back to a depth of 192 feet on the west side to a depth of 201 feet on the east side and being 65 feet across the rear.
