with interest from date at the rate of six (6) per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid quarterly ~~monthly~~, and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and we have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said Henry P. Willimon and Walter W.

Goldsmith in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Volona P. Gray, her heirs and assigns, forever:

all that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situated at the southeast intersection of North Main Street and Kenwood Street in or near the City of Greenville, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southeast corner of the intersection of North Main Street and Kenwood Street (Gallivan Street) and running thence along said street S. 65-17 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 20-10 W. 125 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 65-17 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence along North Main Street N. 20-10 E. 125 feet to the beginning corner.
