"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot #3 on a plat of the property of Ella S. A. Cox as

nated as Lot #3 on a plat of the property of Ella S. A. Cox as made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, under date of July 29, 1944, recorded in Plat Book O, Page 129, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Robert A. Cox by Mary Ellen Cox Robinson and others by deed dated March 20, 1945, recorded in Deed Book 273, Page 308.
