MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I. David W. Balentine, of Greenville County
(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:
WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of
Twenty Thousand and $No/100$
therein specified in installments of One Hundred Thirty-Eight and 19/100 (\$ 138.19). Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable. 25 years after date; and
WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot 366 of a subdivision known as Botany Woods, Sector V, as amended on January 15, 1965 according to a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book JJJ, pages 66 and 67 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Southwick Lane (formerly Abelia Drive), joint front corner of Lots 265 and 366 and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 51-52 E. 117.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 40-02 W. 165.2 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 366 and 367; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 36-12 W. 153.7 feet to an iron pin on the southeastern side of Southwick Lane; thence with the southeastern side of Southwick Lane, N. 63-39 E. 55 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the southeastern side of Southwick Lane, N. 74-32 E. 75 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to me by Botany Woods, Inc. by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 803 at Page 548."
