All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being on the Southeastern side of Putman Road, Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 1 as shown on a plat of Property of J. K. Keller, prepared by W. J. Riddle, dated April, 1948, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book U at page 97, said plat being a resubdivision of the greater part of Lots Nos. 23 and 24 as shown on a plat of Farr Estates, prepared by Dalton & Neves, dated July, 1941, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book M at page 19, and having according to the first mentioned plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Putman Road at the joint front corner of Lot No. 1 and Lot No. 25 of the Farr Estates, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 25 of the Farr Estates S. 30-30 E. 270.2 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence with the line of Lot No. 2 N. 82-22 W. 262.5 feet to an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Putman Road; thence with the curve of the Southeastern side of Putman Road, the chord of which is N. 0-38 E. 79 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the curve of the Southeastern side of Putman Road, the chord of which is N. 32-10 E. 79 feet to an iron pin; thence still continuing with the curve of the Southeastern side of Putman Road, the chord of which is N. 32-10 E. 79 feet to an iron pin; thence still continuing with the curve of the Southeastern side of Putman Road, the chord of which is N. 57-0 E. 95.5 feet to the point of beginning.
