JAMES ROY LOOPER (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of

Two Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100-----DOLLARS (\$ 2,500.00), with interest thereon at the rate of six and three-fourths per cent per annum as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date herewith payable as therein stated, or as hereafter modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is eight years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, on the southern side of Harvley Street, being shown as Lot 17 on plat of W. M. Jordan, et al. recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E at Page 214 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Harvley Street at the joint front corner of Lots 16 and 17 and running thence with the line of Lot 16, S. 1-56 W. 139.4 feet to pin on the northern side of Bull's Alley; thence along said alley, N. 87-43 W. 50 feet to pin at the rear corner of Lot 18; thence with the line of Lot 18, N. 1-56 E. 139.1 feet to pin on the southern side of Harvley Street; thence with the southern side of said street, S. 88-04 E. 50 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to me by E. Inman, Master for Greenville County, by deed to be recorded herewith."

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
