April 27, 1967 and each month thereafter until paid in full, payments to be
applied first to the interest and then to the principal, with the right of anticipation
at any time in any amount.

with interest
from date at the rate of six per centum per annum
until paid; interest to be computed and paid monthly and if unpaid when due to
bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and we have further promised and agreed to pay ten per
cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal
proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said Jack J. Wooten and Henry E. Wooten

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and
also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before
the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
M. L. Knight, his heirs and assigns:

ALL that parcel or tract of land in Glassy Mountain Township of Greenville
County, South Carolina, located about 1.5 miles southwesterly of Glassy Rock,
being the greater portion of a tract of land designated as 38 acres, more or less,
on a plat of property made for the H. E. Pittman Estate by J. Q. Bruce, Surveyor,
dated May 2, 1959, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on a stone on the Ora Turner line, on the western boundary of the
tract conveyed herein, and runs thence with the Turner line, N. 5 E. 1395 feet
through a large pine to a black gum at corner on line of the Ed Means tract;
thence with tract now or formerly owned by Means, N. 67-45 E. 732 feet to a
locust stump, old mark; thence S. 7 W. 396 feet to a stone on the George Pittman
line; thence S. 7 W. 785.4 feet to a locust stake on the Ollie P. Hughes line;
thence continuing with that line, S. 1/2 E. 858 feet to the center of a spring;
thence following the meanders of branch created by spring and down same as
the line by large rock (old mark) and sweet gum (old mark) to a stake at the
center of road; thence along and with the center of road as follows: N. 39 W.
141 feet, N. 85 W. 236 feet and N. 57 W. 82 feet to a stake in said road; thence
N. 47-35 E. 673 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 34 acres, more or
less, by estimation.
