## MORTGAGE RELEASE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT We, MANLEY FURMAN HAYWOOD, NANNIE ELIZABETH HAYWOOD ROGERS and ALLIE MACK HAYWOOD PAZDAN, Executors of the Estate of Martha Pearl Haywood, do for certain valuable consideration, release from the lien and operation of our Mortgage the real estate hereinafter described so that the said real estate shall be free and unaffected by said Mortgage, which Mortgage is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Mortgage Book 1027, Page 484. The property to be released under this instrument is described as follows:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Northwestern side of Haywood Road containing 33.06 acres, more or less, as shown on Plat entitled "Haywood Property to be conveyed to Duke Power Co." dated March 28, 1967, revised March 31, 1967, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book PPP, at Page 103, and having according to said Plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Haywood Road and running thence N. 38-58 W. 181.10 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 73-45 W. 363.0 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing S. 73-45 W. approximately 15 feet to a point in the center of a creek; thence in a Northwesterly direction with the creek as the line, said creek having traverse lines from the last mentioned iron pin with the following courses and distances: N. 23-16 W. 70.0 feet, N. 21-36 W. 85.0 feet, N. 27-39 W. 250.0 feet, N. 37-26 W. 100.0 feet, N. 42-32 W. 100.0 feet, N. 46-28 W. 180.20 feet, N. 48-22 W. 380.0 feet and N. 56-23 W. 64.70 feet to an iron pin near the Western bank of said creek and thence in a Northeasterly direction to a point in the center of said creek being the Westernmost corner of the property herein conveyed; thence in a Southeasterly direction measured from the last mentioned iron pin S. 53-25 E. 442.26 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 35-13 E. 182.80 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 33-12 E. 100.0
