NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Rachel W. Floyd

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and
also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before
the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Southern Bank and Trust Company, Greenville, S. C., its successors and assigns
forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State
of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, being known
and designated as Lot No. 85 of a subdivision known as Pine Hill Village, as shown
on plat prepared by R. K. Campbell, R. L. S., November 30, 1960, and recorded in
the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, at Page 168, and having,
according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Cashmere Drive, the joint
front corner of Lots Nos. 84 and 85, and running thence along the joint line of
said lots, S 28-10 W 137.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corners of Lots
