NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, situate between Augusta Road and Old Augusta Road, in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot 2.1, Block 1, Page 211 of the County Block Book, and having according to survey made by C. O. Riddle, June 1962, the following metes and bounds:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin near the western edge of the sidewalk running along the western edge of Augusta Road, at the corner of property known as Cedar Lane Gardens, and running thence S. 80-33 W. 281.4 feet to iron pin on the eastern edge of Old Augusta Road; thence with the eastern side of Old Augusta Road S. 9-27 W. 22.7 feet to pin; thence N. 81-30 E. 102 feet to pin; thence S. 5-00 E. 26 feet to pin at corner of property now or formerly owned by Anabel Thomas, and running thence with said property S. 9-27 W. 50 feet to pin in line of property now or formerly owned by George Cahaly; thence with line of said property N. 82-15 E. 210.55 feet to iron pin, which pin is .5 feet S. 82-15 W. from edge of sidewalk along Augusta Road; thence with the western side of Augusta Road N. 13-13 W. 103.8 feet to the point of beginning."
