, with interest thereon from

at the rate of per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing

for an attorney's fee of none besides all costs and expense of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

All the piece, parcel or lot of land situated and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, in Oak Lawn Township, being Lot #4 of the subdivision of W. L. Woodson, reference being made to a plat by G. M. Smith, Surveyor, December 10, 1958, recorded in the R M C Office for said County in Plat Book 00 at page 179.

This is one of the lots conveyed to the grantor by deed of F H Eskew, et al., dated June 16, 1962, recored in the R M C Office aforsaid in Deed Book 701 at page 168.

In said Eskew deed an incorrect reference was made to a plat recorded in Plat Book 00 at page 115, the correct reference being that shown in the above description.
