Harry E. Dawson, two-thirds interest, and Chas. A. Mundy, a one-third interest,

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the northeastern side of Pine Ridge Drive in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No. 35 of Plat 1, Section 2 as shown on Map of Fresh Meadow Farms, made for L. A. Moseley and C. Henry Brannon by Madison H. Woodward, R. E. May 21, 1945 said plat recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in plat book S at page 61, reference being craved thereto for a complete description.

This mortgage is junior in lien to that certain mortgage held by Cameron-Brown Company in the original amount of \$14,000.00 recorded in vol. 959 page 359.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, his or its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

(1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the convenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgagor by the Mortgage so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing.
