"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, situate on the south-western side of Golf Course Road, also known as S. C. Highway 106, being shown as Lot 13 on plat of Property of William R. Timmons, Jr., dated May 1966, prepared by C. O. Riddle, and recorded in Plat Book 000 at Page 95 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Golf Course Road, joint front corner of Lots 13 and 14, and running thence with line of Lot 14, S. 60-31 W. 415 feet to iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 13 and 14; thence N. 29-29 W. 210 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 12 and 13; thence with Lot 12, N. 60-31 E. 415 feet to iron pin on Golf Course Road; thence with said Road S. 29-29 E. 210 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2 acres."
